NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Ellen T. Arnold
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars and other considerations --- DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. A. Bull

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. A. Bull, his heirs and assigns my one half interest in all that tract of land situate in Chick Springs Township, in the County and State aforesaid, containing twenty five and four fifths acres, more or less, and being all of the tract of land that was conveyed by N. C. Caldwell on the 10th day of January 1910, deed recorded in Vol. 5, page 421, less two acres that was conveyed to Aaron M. Crary by deed dated the 20th day of January 1912, recorded in Volume 19, page 184: The said Caldwell tract contained twenty seven and four fifths acres, is fully described in said deed from J. T. Flynn to J. A. Bull and J. Thos. Arnold and recorded in R. M. C. Office Vol. 18, page 433, and from J. Thos. Arnold to Ellen T. Arnold by deed dated second day of January, 1918 and recorded in R. M. C. Office Vol. 47, page 157.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. A. Bull his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself J. A. Bull heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. A. Bull heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
