 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower  
 of the City of Greenville in the State aforesaid  
 in consideration of the sum of Dallie Jackson - DOLLARS,  
 to US in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Six hundred and fifty Dollars -

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Dallye Jackson, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on Jenkins Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Jenkins Street, and running thence S. 23 W. 127-1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 68-1/2 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 23 E. 127-1/2 feet to an iron pin on Jenkins Street; thence along Jenkins Street N. 68-1/2 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being one of the lots of land conveyed to us by Jos. A. McCullough, by deed dated September 11th, 1916 and recorded in the R.H.C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 36, page 139.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Dallye Jackson, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND WE do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Dallye Jackson, his heirs and assigns, against ourselves and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
