 in consideration of the sum of Five DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. M. Sudduth

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. M. Sudduth, All that piece of Parcel or tract of land being my County and State aforesaid on waters of South Tyger River and has the following courses and distances to-wit: Beginning on M. M. Mitchell's line corner of J. B. L. Sudduth, thence N. 55 1/2 E. 390 ch. to a stake in Gap Creek Road, along said road in Northern direction crossing Wild Cat creek to a stone, thence S. 88 1/2 W. 16.55 ch. to a stone, thence S. 20 W. 5.60 ch. to a stone in old Road, thence along said Road S. 88 1/2 E. 6.35 ch. to stone in Road, thence S. 4 1/2 W. 150 ch. to a stone, thence S. 62 1/2 E. 22.00 ch. to Beginning Corner, containing Twenty seven acres more or less, adjoining lands of J. B. L. Sudduth, W. M. Mitchell and others. This deed is made on condition that J. T. Sudduth and his wife E. C. Sudduth are to receive customary rents of this tract of land during their natural lives and at their death W. M.
