 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. R. Casin of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable Considerations DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by George Brownlee

(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said George Brownlee, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and in the State of South Carolina, Beginning at a point one hundred (100) feet from East side of Augusta Street, corner of lot formerly owned by George Brownlee, and running thence S 47 1/4 E. Sixty-two (62) feet on line between hotel property and lot no 7 and to iron pin on alley; thence N. 38 E. with said alley, fifty (50) feet to a pin between lots nos. 5 & 6; thence with line of lot no 5 Sixty (60) feet to corner of lot formerly owned by George Brownlee, one Hundred (100) feet from East side of Augusta Street; thence S 40 1/2 W. with line of said lot formerly owned by George Brownlee, fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner, and being the rear portion of lots nos 1 and 7 as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office in Greenville County S. C. in Dred Book E. C. G. page 301 and as a part of the lot conveyed to me by W. R. and C. E. M. Brayer and made in S. B. Charles by deed dated November 11th, 1907 and recorded in said R. M. C. office in Vol. W. P. Page 674.

AND I do hereby bind Myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said George Brownlee, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
