A. M. Rush DEED TO *D. S. Webb*

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *D. A. M. Rush, of the City of Greenville* in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of ~~Fourteen thousand and Fifty (\$14,500.00)~~ DOLLARS,
to *Me* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *D. S. Webb*.

(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *D. S. Webb*, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, on the South side of Earle Street in the City of Greenville, having the following lines and bounds, beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Earle Street at corner of lot purchased by *A. P. Hussey*, and running thence with Sussex line $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 26$ feet hundred (200) feet to stake; thence N $84\frac{1}{2}$ W Sixty-five and one half $65\frac{1}{2}$ feet to stake; thence N. $5\frac{1}{2}$ E Two hundred (200) feet to stake on Earle Street; thence with Earle Street $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 6$ Sixty-five and one half ($65\frac{1}{2}$) feet to the beginning corner. Reference is had to the plat of the Stone Land made up of *R. Southern* Sept. 14th 1888 recorded in *Book 6, Office of Greenville County, Book 21, M. M. Page 542*, and being the same lot conveyed to *F. G. Philpiper* by the Stone Land Company and by the said *F. G. Philpiper* to *S. S. Stone*, and by the said *S. S. Stone* conveyed to me by deed bearing date May 30, 1911, recorded in *Book 13, Page 34*.
