NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. Floride S. Miller of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other good and valuable consideration to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. E. Coy

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. E. Coy, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the north side of Stone Avenue, and having the following meter and bounds, according to plat made by R. E. Dalton, April 1919. Beginning at an iron pin, corner of lot no. 14 and running thence with Stone Avenue, S. 83.17 E. Sixty (60) feet to corner of lot no. 19; thence with the line of lot no. 19 N. 2.04 E. one hundred, ninety one and four tenths (191.4) feet to an iron pin in rear line of lot no. 8; thence with the rear line of lot no. 8 and 9 N. 84.19 W. Sixty (60) feet to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 14. thence with the line of lot no. 14 S. 2.03 W. one hundred, ninety and three tenths (190.3) feet to the beginning corner and designated as lot no. 18, as shown on plat hereinabove referred to.
