NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That... Minnie J. Watson of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten and 10/100 and other good and valuable Consideration DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by... Marie J. Wells.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Marie J. Wells, and her heirs and assigns, all that certain piece parcel, place or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County and City of Greenville in the First ward of said City of Greenville on the corner of Bunccombe Street and Briggsville Avenue; and having the following lines, mites and boundaries to wit: Beginning at an iron pin, corner of Bunccombe Street and Briggsville Avenue (Formerly known as Finlay Street) and running thence in a southerly direction along south side of Briggsville Avenue, 134 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence along the East side of said alley 58 feet to an iron pin, corner of Smith's lot; thence along Smith's line 119 feet to an iron pin on Bunccombe Street; thence along Bunccombe Street 61 feet to the beginning corner this being a part of the land, conveyed to me by C. W. M. Watson by deed dated 1st day of Sept. 1910 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Vol #17 of Deeds at page 472, to which reference is hereby made.
