 in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) DOLLARS,  
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by T. L. Coastles

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said T. L. Coastles, all those three (3) lots of land in said County and State, near the Paris Mountain Road known as 48, 49 and 50 of Block "A" of a Subdivision known as "Newland", being the same three lots conveyed to me by H. G. Batson on June 18, 1917 by deed, recorded in Vol. 45 page 33, reference to same being hereby made.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said T. L. Coastles, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind me + my T. L. Coastles, his heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
