(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mr. T. M. Dillard, all that certain piece, parcel, or tract, of land situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, lying partly on the Gibbs Shoal Road, and having the following corners, and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the Gibbs Shoal Road and running thence S. 86° 26' 8.21 chains to a stone; thence N. 12° 4' E. 5.47 chains to a stone; thence S. 83° E. 11.63 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 11° W. 10 chains to an iron pin between Maple and poplar trees; thence along same straight line S. 21° E. 11.63 chains to a stone; thence S. 86° 26' 8.21 chains to the Gibbs Shoal Road; thence up said road N. 3° E. 6.26 chains to the beginning corner. This being a part of the estate of J. C. Dillard.
