NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I John H. Putnam of Simpsonville, S. C. in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Forty DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R. N. Morton of Greenville County,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R. N. Morton, all that lot or parcel of land lying being and situate in the County and State aforesaid, containing twelve acres, more or less, and both the following metes and bounds to wit: Bound by Sullivan, said R. N. Morton, Vaughn and myself, commencing at a stone said Morton's corner running thence N. 5 1/4 E. 100.76 to a stone 3x; thence S. 88 1/4 E. 6.66 to a stone 3x; thence S 6 N. 17.66 to a stone 3x; thence S. 83 1/4 W. 6.74 to beginning corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said R. N. Morton and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself & my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said R. N. Morton and his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
