 in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Audy Reese

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Audy Reese, all that piece parcel and tract of land lying situate and being in Paris Mountain Township, State and County aforesaid, known as a part of the land conveyed to me by deed from J. W. Gray, Master and a part of lot no. 12 in the division of Gab Thompson estate, adjoining lands of myself Wm Thompson and others. Beginning with iron pin on the White Horse Road, thence running N. 34 W. 1.10 to fork of Road, thence with the Finley Bridge Road N. 55 W. 82.5 to a stake; thence S. 57 3/4 W. 12.50 to a stake on a branch, thence up said branch to a stake on branch, thence N. 57 3/4 E. 12.00 to the beginning corner, and contains ten acres be the same more or less.
