

Amanda C. Austin DEED TO Lawrence Moore

Now, know all men by these presents, That I, Amanda C. Austin

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Lawrence Moore

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Lawrence Moore, his heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in East Township, having the following water and bounds to wit: Beginning at a pine on the corner adjoining Mrs. Meyers' property, running a fence N. 4 E. Eight hundred and fifty-eight feet across the White Horse Road to a pin; thence N. 34-30 W. 196 feet to a pin; thence S. 20 W. 1134 feet to a pine on Lawrence Moore's corner; thence N 86-30 E. 458 feet to the beginning corner, containing 7 and 7/10 acres more or less. Being a portion of the land conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master of Greenville County.

As a part of the consideration of this conveyance, the said Lawrence Moore does hereby assume and agree to pay a note secured by mortgage on the premises herein conveyed in the sum of one thousand and no. 00 Dollars, said note being given to J. Frank Epps, Attorney, dated January 20, 1917.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Lawrence Moore, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Lawrence Moore, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
