NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. R. Hale, Jr.,
of the County of Greenville
in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other ^{consideration} valuable, in the State aforesaid,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Horace A. Tansill

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Horace A. Tansill: All that certain lot of land
situate on the north side of the National Highway
at Paris, in the County and State aforesaid, known
and designated as lot #3 of sub-division of W. D.
Parrish, as shown on plat made by R. E. Dalton
July, 1917, recorded in Plat Book "E" page 46 and
having the following metes and bounds to-wit:
Beginning at stake on the north side of the National
Highway at corner of lot #4, being 25 feet from the
west side of Moorey Road, and running thence
with line of lot #4, N. 36-43 W. 50 feet to stake in
line of lot #5; thence with line of lot #5 S. 53-40
W. 25 feet to stake corner of lot #2; thence with line
of lot #2 S. 36-43 E. 50 feet to stake on National
Highway, thence with National Highway N. 53-40 E.
