(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
D. E. Connor all that piece, parcel or lot ^{of land} situate, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, in Chick Springs Township near the town of Green, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Buncombe road and run thence with Buncombe road 190 feet to an iron pin on C. L. King and J. P. Few's line; thence N. 60. E. 397 feet to an iron pin, C. L. King's corner; thence along this line N. 64 E 228 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60 W. about 513 feet to the beginning corner, containing two acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said D. E. Connor his heirs and assigns, forever.
