NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. N. Green
of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and eighty (\$780.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. G. Green of the State and
County aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
G. G. Green all of that certain piece, parcel, and lot of land
situate in the State and County aforesaid, near Poplar
Mountain Baptist Church, adjoining lands of Peck King, John
Cole and others, being a part of a sixty five acre tract of land
purchased by me from J. M. Chaudler and recorded in Book
S. G. page 726 17th Dec. 1875 and having the following metes and
bounds: Beginning on iron pin in road, thence N. 21 W. 4.81
chains to W. O. theyco N. 7 E. 77 links to iron pin in ranch,
thence down the ranch N. 36 3/4 W. 2.24 to stone, thence N. 45
E. 188 to stone, thence N. 45 1/2 W. 2.00 to stone, thence S. 39 E. 19.34
to iron pin in road, thence N. 50 3/4 E. 3.52 to the beginning
