McCall his heirs & assigns, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying & being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the town of Piedmont & known as the Dr. Thos. G. Crumnes place containing one & six tenths (1 6/10) acre, more or less & having the following lines & boundaries to wit: Beginning in the center of the Peeler Road; thence S. 12° E. 3.20 chains to a stake in road; thence S. 10° E. 3.18 chains to a stone trigee S. 12 1/2 W. 1.58 chains to a stone; thence S. 70° E. 1.74 chains to an iron stake; thence N. 70° E. 3.50 chains to the beginning corner, subject however, to the right of way of the Southern Railway under the rear of the premises; said lot of land being the same conveyed to J.
