-NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Cestrate Thomason of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of Twenty six hundred and fifty  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
C. P. Armstrong

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
C. P. Armstrong Jan- 1st- 1918. all that piece parcel  
or lot of land situated lying and being in the  
Town of Fountain Inn, State of South Carolina  
Greenville County lying on North side of Main  
Street and having the following metes and  
bounds to wit- Beginning on main Street at corner  
of Sam Hughes lot, running thence with Main Street  
S. 58 3/4 E. 155 to stone 3/4 thence N. 37 3/4 W. 220 to  
stone 3/4 thence S. 33 1/4 W. 624 to beginning corner  
containing one and one tenth acres more or less.  
Less twenty feet on back of lot running the entire  
width of the lot conveyed to town of Fountain Inn  
S. C. on Westover Street. Bounded by Main Street, Sam  
Hughes Westover Street and Mamie C. Woods Lots.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
