(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. L. B. Paysinger, her heirs and assigns forever:  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, near the eastern limits of the City of Greenville in section known as "Overbrook", and being designated as lot No. 36 as shown on plat of H.
