in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and Fifty and no/100 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
L. P. Mayfield

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
L. P. Mayfield, all that tract piece, or parcel of land  
situate lying and being in the County and State  
aforesaid, adjoining lands of L. P. Mayfield, J. T. Vaughn  
and others, and having the following metes and  
bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone 3x7 in. and  
running thence N. 2 1/2 W. 20.25 to a stone 3x7 in. on  
the Mayfield line; thence N. 77 W. 6.50 to a stone  
N.M. on said line, thence S. 2 1/2 E. 12.10 to a  
stone 3x7 in. thence S. 46 E. 9.50 to the beginning  
corner and containing Ten and one half (10 1/2) acres  
more or less.
