(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

H. P. Mayfield, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, known as lot #1 of the home tract, situate lying and being on Pelham road in Black Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, Beginning at a stone 3x on Pelham road, thence S. 51 3/4 E. 2.50 chs. to turn in road, thence S. 72 1/4 E. 2.70 chs to stone 3x thence S. 37 E. 2.15 chs. to rock in ranch; thence S. 15 N. 23 links to center of spring; thence S. 67 E. 7.00 chs to stone 3x; thence S. 79 N. 3.25 chs. to stone 3x on ranch, thence S. 24 1/2 E. 3.80 chs. to stone 3x; thence S. 27 1/2 N. 3.50 chs to stone 3x; thence N. 36.30 to stone 3x; thence N. 11.
