(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. Lawrence Bently: All that certain piece parcel or lot of land, situate ^{lying} and being in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, in Ward 6, of the City of Greenville, and having a frontage of 60 feet, on Augusta Street, and being lot number 3, according to a Plat of the Mrs F. E. Harris property said plat made by W. D. Meves and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 261, this being one of the lots conveyed to me by Sallie H. Harris and et al by deed dated Jan. 28th. 1916 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Volume 37 of deeds at page 454.
