 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. R. Gillespie

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. R. Gillespie, All that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County State aforesaid, containing forty-eight and eighty-one one hundredths (48 ⁸¹/₁₀₀) acres more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed of W. M. Stenhouse and W. S. Peden, said Deed being recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County South Carolina in Vol. 51 page 138 to which reference is made for a fuller description as to lines corners, distances &c. bounded by lands of M. R. L. Peden, the said W. R. Gillespie and others.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W. R. Gillespie his heirs and assigns, forever.
