(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Jones and his heirs and assigns, all of my undivided one-tenth interest in all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Butler Township in the County and State aforesaid about five and one half miles from the City of Greenville, containing twenty-five acres, more or less, and adjoining lands of Perry Hudson, L. A. Green, and others and known as the Frances Chandler place.
