NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Walter W. Hamilton in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of one dollar, love and affection DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Army Gertrude League

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Army Gertrude League, All that lot or parcel of land in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, containing one-half acre more or less, and having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at a locust post corner of J. W. Roe's land on Buncombe Road, thence along said road northerly (78) Seventy-eight feet to a stake; thence easterly (280 feet) two hundred and eighty feet to a cedar post; thence southerly (78) seventy eight feet to a stake; thence westerly (280) two hundred and eighty feet to the corner of beginning, bounded by lands of J. W. Roe, W. W. Hamilton and Buncombe Road.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Army Gertrude League her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Army Gertrude League and her

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

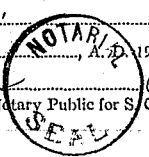
