 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, A White

in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other good and valuable ^{considerations} DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. B. Lindsay

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged); have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. B. Lindsay. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate in the State and County aforesaid in section about 3 miles Southeast of the Greenville County Court House, known as Fallis and being known and designated as lot No. 7 of Section One (1) of Fallis Annex, as shown by a plat thereof made by E. D. News, C. E. March 1913 and on record in the office of "R. M. C" for Greenville County in Plat Book Q at page 101 and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat; Commencing at a stake on the West side of the White Horse Road, joint corners with lots Nos 6 and 7 and running thence S 64.30 W 200 feet to a stake; thence S 24 E 63 feet to a stake; thence N 64-30 E 200 feet to a stake on White Horse Road; thence with said White Horse Road, N 24 E 63 feet to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. B. Lindsay his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. B. Lindsay, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
