Baptist Church (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

stituting the Board of Deacons of City View Baptist Church,
the following described real estate, to-wit: All that piece or
parcel of land, situate lying and being in Greenville County,
State aforesaid, and being a part of lots 5, 6 and 7 Block 10
of City View Land Company as shown on plat made by F. S.
Drogers which is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Plat Book A. Page 327, and more particularly
described, as follows: Beginning at a point on Summit
Street fifty feet distant from the intersection of Y. M. C. A.
and Summit Streets and running thence along
