 in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Lella Campbell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lella Campbell, all that piece or parcel of land in Highland Township and County and State aforesaid on the south side of Middle Tiger River and known as a part of the Laret Bruce place, beginning on a stone corner of G. W. Morrow and F. L. Turner running thence west to a stone corner of J. L. Campbell and F. L. Turner, running thence north west to a stone thence near north to a wild cherry tree near a grave yard thence to a stone on the south bank of Middle Tiger River, thence down and with the meanderings of said River to a stone on the G. W. Morrow line thence with G. W. Morrow line to a stone the beginning corner bounded by lands of G. W. Morrow B. F. Henson and J. L. Campbell, and containing twenty acres (20) more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Lella Campbell her heirs and assigns, forever.
