NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Lena W. Stone
 in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Two Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by No. P. M^e Lee

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said No. P. M^e Lee, All that certain piece parcel outlot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, on the South side of Randall Street, Beginning at a stake two Hundred feet from the South west corner of Wilton and Randall Streets and running thence S. 10-41 W. two hundred feet to a stake; thence N. 83-13 W. fifty five feet to a stake thence N. 1-41 E. two hundred feet to a stake on Randall Street, thence with Randall Street S. 83-13 E. fifty five feet to the beginning and being part of lots Nos. 25 and 27 of Sect. "B" as shown on a plat of Stone Land Company, said plat recorded in Plat Book "A" pages 334-345, conveyed to Mattie V. M^e Entire by Rosa W. Marchbanks June 29, 1917 and conveyed to me by Mattie V. M^e Entire June 30, 1917, deed recorded in Vol. 45 page 32.
