 in consideration of the sum of Thirty-Five Hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. P. League

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said G. P. League, his heirs and assigns, all that piece of real estate in the town of Simpsonville and located at the corner of Church and Academy Streets on the South side of Academy Street and on the West side of Church Street, measuring 100 feet on Church Street and 200 feet on Academy Street, and known as the "Dormitory Lot", same being a lot taken from a piece of land deeded to me by J. J. Wilson.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said G. P. League and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said G. P. League and heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
