

Jannos George DEED TO J. E. Robbins

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Jannos George
in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. E. Robbins

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. E. Robbins, all those three lots of land, situated in Ward five of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, together fronting one hundred and fifty (150) feet on the South side of Dunbar Street and having a depth of 215 feet and containing in aggregate 32,250 square feet more or less. For a description by metes and bounds and course and distances see Plat Book "A" page 163 in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State, these parcels of land being numbered on said plat as, 6, 7 and 8. Lots 6 and 7 were conveyed to W. W. Williamson by W. H. Irvine, deceased, on June 17th 1909 by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Volume 7, page 468, and lot No. 8 was conveyed to W. W. Williamson by Mrs. Sallie C. Williamson. On lot No. 6 there is a small store building.

J. E. Robbins, his heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
