NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We H. D. Parrish and T. C. Howes

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

A. G. Vaughan
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
A. G. Vaughan, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of
land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville
and County of Greenville, State aforesaid and on the
south side of the Laurens Road. Beginning at an iron
pin corner of lot No. 72, and running thence in a westerly
direction with said Laurens Road fifty feet to corner
of lot No. 74; thence with line of lot No. 74, one hundred
and forty-one feet and ten inches to point on rear line
of lot No. 77; thence S. 48-30 E. fifty three feet to rear corner
of lot No. 72; thence in a North easterly direction one
hundred and sixty feet along line of lot No. 72 to
the Laurens Road, the beginning corner. Being lot
No. 73 according to plat thereof now recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "K"
Page 383. Being one of the lots conveyed to us by J.
