 and does in consideration of the sum of One DOLLAR\$,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by The said Ida Bright

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Ida Bright all that piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, as follows: Lot No. 1 of the Spartaw branch land founded on the North by Mildred Jackson on the West by Lemuel Crane on the South by lot No. 2 on the East by the Jackson land containing (40) Forty acres more or less.

But it is expressly understood that I the said Mary P. Bright am to have the sole controll of the tract of land herein to be conveyed, and the full benefit of all the rents issues &c arising from the within tract of land hereby conveyed during my natural life and in no event shall this deed of conveyance take effect during my natural life.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Ida Bright, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Ida Bright (after my death) her heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
