in consideration of the sum of one Hundred DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. A. Fowler of Greenville County

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
W. A. Fowler, all that lot or parcel of land lying being
and situate in Fairview Township County said State
aforesaid, the same being a part of my home place
and contains Eight Tenths of an acre more or less
and hath the following wites and bounds to-wit:
Bound by said W. A. Fowler and myself, commencing
at a stone running thence S 17 1/2 E. 447 to a stone
thence N. 24 1/2 E. 5.35 to a stone, thence S 80 W. 3.55
to Beginning corner, this being a part of the land sold
to D. R. Mahaffey.
