J. H. Arnold, my right and title to all that piece parcel
 or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County
State of South Carolina in the city of Greenville, on the
North side of Elford street, between North Main and
Courtes Streets said lot of land having a frontage of
eighty two feet and two inches on Elford Street, and
