(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
R. B. Lindsey, her heirs and assigns. All that
 certain piece or lot of land situate, lying and being
 in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville
 about two and one half miles South West from Greenville
 Court House near Brandon Mills, on the P. & N. Ry. line,
 and being known and designated as lot # 56, on a plot
 which is recorded in plat book B at page 190 in R.M.
C office for Greenville County, and having such metes
 and bounds as appear in the plat above referred to,
 this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by
J.M. Steele and S.H. Park by deed dated Jan. 2nd
1818 and recorded in the R.M. C for said county and
 State in Vol. # 28 of deeds at page 586 to which reference
 is hereby made
