(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto, the said

Analia King, All that piece parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the South-side of Webster Street in Ward four of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being known as lot number (8) eight on the subdivision of the W. C.
