(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

M. E. Blakley all that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Grove Township of Greenville and State aforesaid, containing ninety one (91) acres more or less and having the following metes and bounds, Beginning at a stone on ow creek bank and running thence S. 73 N. 30.00 chains to 37 0 m. thence S. 44 1/2 N. 1.75 to iron pin on creek bank at Brasier's corner, thence up creek with Brasier's line 0.50 to iron pin 37 thence S. 88 E. 13.01 to iron pin 37 thence N. 23 1/4 N. 5.06 to iron pin 37 in public road, thence N. 24 N. 16.00 to a sweet gum 37 0 m. thence N. 47 1/2 E. 2.75 to a stone on creek thence down meanderings of said creek as a line 4.72 to iron pin 37 N. m. thence N. 73 1/4 E. 39.38 to center of creek just above mentioned, thence down meanderings of said creek to the beginning corner and lying by lands of J.
