 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Eugene A. Gilfillin and Louis B. Houston in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. G. Sanderson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. G. Sanderson, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situated on the North Side of East Stone Avenue in Black located between Wilton and Robinson Streets, and known as lot 7 on map No 5 of a subdivision of the Stone and said being recorded by Vol 466 page No. 604 R.M. C. Office for Greenville County, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on said Stone Avenue one hundred sixty-three feet (163') from the Northeast corner of said Stone Avenue and Robinson Street: thence N. 5 1/2 E two hundred feet (200') to a stake: thence S 84 1/2 E fifty-four 1/3 feet (54 1/3) to a stake (this point being Southwest corner of lot 7 on said plat): thence S 5 1/2 E two hundred feet (200') to a stake on line of Stone Avenue: thence with fast mentioned S 84 1/2 E fifty-four 1/3 feet (54 1/3) to the beginning corner. Reference being had to said plat will more fully appear. Being the same lot of land conveyed to us by Mountain City Land & Improvement Company by deed dated December 18, 1912, and recorded in R.M.
