 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *J. N. Sudduth* in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of *Five* DOLLARS,
 to *me* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. T. P. Sudduth*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *J. T. P. Sudduth*, all that piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the waters of South Tyger River and has the following courses and distances, to wit: Beginning on Wm. Mitchell's line (corner of *J. B. Sudduth*) thence N. $55\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.90 chains to a stake in Gap Creek Road thence along said road in Northern direction crossing Wildcat Creek to a stone thence S $88\frac{1}{2}$ W. 16.55 chs. to a stone, thence S 20 E. 5.60 ch to a stone in old Road thence along said Road S $88\frac{1}{2}$ E. 6.35 ch to stone in Road thence S $4\frac{1}{2}$ E. 150 ch to a stone thence S $62\frac{1}{2}$ E. 22.00 ch to the beginning corner. Containing Twenty-seven (27) Acres, more or less, Adjoining lands of *J. B. Sudduth* Wm. Mitchell, and others. This deed is made on the conditions that *J. N. Sudduth* and his wife, *E. C.
