 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Charles W. Mitchell

in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other considerations DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Oscar M. Mitchell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Oscar M. Mitchell a certain tract or parcel of land, situate
 in Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the north side
 of South Tyger river beginning on a post oak 3x on the north
 bank of said river and running thence N. 44 1/4 E. 36.00 to a
 small Red oak 3x on the bank of a branch at an old ford,
 thence up and with said branch to a maple 3x above the
 head of S. F. Reuser line. Thence N. 49 W. 15.96 to a Black oak
3x. Thence S. 35 1/2 W. 12.23 to a Black oak 3x 3x, thence N.
55 W. to a stone 3x (Judson Hendersons corner) Thence S. with
 the said Hendersons line to a stone near the mouth of branch
 on the north bank of South Tyger river. Thence down said
 river with meanderings of the same to the beginning corner
 containing One Hundred and sixty acres more or less.

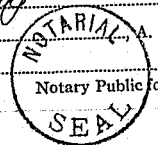
TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
