 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Will Mays, his heirs and assigns all that piece
parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in
Gantt Township, Greenville County South Carolina,
containing three and one half acres more or less;
Beginning at a stone on the Meyers corner and
Alfred Walker lands and running thence N. 3. E. 5.38
to stake, thence N. 87. W. 6.50 to stake, thence S. 3. W.
5.38 to stake, thence S. 89 E. 6.50 to the beginning corner
& being the same land conveyed to me by Will Mays,
Sam Mays & Mary Brown April 19-1919,
