 NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Mrs. Walter Henderson and Frank Henderson in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred 00/100 DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Fred Wilson of Simpsonville, S. C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Fred Wilson, all that certain lot or parcel of land, situated lying and being in the town of Simpsonville County, and State aforesaid East of Street running from old Georgia Road in a southerly direction and running just the rear of S. J. Wilson's residence, Beginning on an iron pin Nannie Wilson's corner, and running thence N. 77 E. 190 1/2 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 14 3/4 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 77 W. 190 1/2 feet to an iron pin on street, thence down said street N. 14 3/4 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the south by Nannie Wilson lot on the west by Hedge Street on the north by A. J. Woods and others land, this being same lot conveyed to me by A. J. Sullivan by deed dated June 1st. 1918 and recorded in office of P. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. Book G. page 28.
