

E. L. Craigs DEED TO Lois Craigs. THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, County of Greenville. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, E. L. Craigs of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five and 00/100 DOLLARS, and the natural love and affection I have for my wife Lois Craigs to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Lois Craigs (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lois Craigs, her heirs and assigns, an undivided one half 1/2 interest of, in and to all those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about 2 miles west of the City of Greenville, and being a portion of a subdivision known as City View, and being known and designated as lots # 92 and 93, according to a plat made by W. L. Adams Surveyor, these being the same two lots conveyed to me by R. F. Hunt, et al., by deed dated June 6th 1917 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Vol. #42 of Deeds, at page 162 to which reference is hereby made.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

Lois Craigs and her heirs and assigns, forever. AND I do hereby bind myself & my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

Lois Craigs and her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
