 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Laura R. Jackson in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Forty-two hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by B. P. Woodside

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B. P. Woodside, his heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of East Avenue in the City of Greenville, at the intersection of McGee Street, and running thence N. 21.45 W. one hundred and fifty-five feet to a pin on an alley; thence with said alley S. 80 W. fifty one feet and eight inches to a pin; thence S. 21.45 E. one hundred and fifty-five feet to a pin on East Avenue; thence with said East Avenue N. 80 E. fifty one feet and eight inches to the beginning, being the lot conveyed to me by Hattie R. Rathrop by deed dated the 11th day of October 1917 and recorded in Vol. 20 at page 227.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said B. P. Woodside, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said B. P. Woodside, his heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
