NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Laura R. Jackson

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. P. P. Carson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. P. P. Carson, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate in the state and county, aforesaid, in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, on the Rowley property and having the following meter and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a pin on the north side East Avenue, 10 3/4 feet; thence from the intersection of Fuller Street and running thence N. 21-45 W. 155 feet to a pin on a ten foot alley; thence with said alley S. 81 W. 51 feet, 8 inches to said alley; thence with said last named alley S. 21-45 E. 155 feet to a pin on East Avenue; thence with said East Avenue, N. 81 E. 51 feet, 8 inches to the point of beginning and being the Western half of the same lot of land conveyed to me, the said Laura R. Jackson by R. J. Rowley, by his deed dated Jul. 31st, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 39 page 550, with the exception of a ten foot alley at the rear of said lot, which is established.
