 in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. K. Pannell and D. J. Pannell; All that certain piece parcel and lot of land, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County and Township of Greenville near the American ~~flaming~~ company on Puckney Street and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on North side of Puckney Street and running thence N. 20-10 E. 190 feet to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence S. 68-50 E. 100 feet along said alley to an iron pin; thence S. 21-10 W. 190 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Puckney Street thence N. 68-50 W. 100 feet along said Puckney Street to the beginning corner, and known as lot # 32 on a plat made by W.
