

W.F. Lindsey DEED TO H.G. Lindsey, THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, County of Greenville

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.F. Lindsey in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H.G. Lindsey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said H.G. Lindsey, All that certain piece, parcel of land situated, lying and being in the aforesaid State and County, head water of South Pacolet River, joining land Emanuel Prewette, Jon. H. Goodwin, James Lindsey, Peter and Thomas Lindsey and others: Beginning on a Hickory, Peter and Thomas Lindsey corner and running thence S.E. to a pine near slick rock; thence westward to a chesnut near Glassy Rock; thence S. 52 W. 480 to a stone inside of Emanuel Prewetts field; thence N. 43 W. 131.5 to a stone nm; thence S. 80 W. 10.00 to a stone 3Xnm, N. 82 W. 10.00 to a rock nm; thence S. 79 W. 650 to a stone RO gone nm; thence N. 86 W. 400 to a chesnut oak nm; thence S. 57 W. 400 to a hickory on the Cliff nm. thence N. 87 W. 13.50 to a W.oak; thence N. 75 W. 7.50 to a long chesnut; thence N.W. to a Chst. Jno.H. Goodwin & James Lindseys corner thence N.84 1/2 E. 15.32 to a Locust poste; thence S. 71 E. 36.00 to the beginning corner, containing eighty acres, more or less in all. Ten acres next to Glassy Rock is excepted - the same being held by James McMakin.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said H.G. Lindsey, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself - heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said H.G. Lindsey, -

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
