NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, W. D. Workman, of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other Valuable Considerations, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by C. H. Harris

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. H. Harris, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the South side of University St. and known and designated as lot no. 5 on a plat of property of W. D. Workman made by R. E. Dalton and filed for record in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following meter and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of University Street, joint corner of lots nos. 4 and 5; thence with line of lot no. 4 S. 37-57 W. one hundred and twenty-four and four tenths (124.4) feet, to an iron pin on line of J. A. Courton's property; thence with line of said Courton property S. 53-38 E. forty nine and eight tenths (49.8) feet to an iron pin joint corner of lots nos. 5 and 6; thence with line of lot no. 6 N. 38-05 E. one hundred and twenty-one and two tenths (121.2) feet, to an iron pin on University Street; thence with line of University Street N. 50-0 W. fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner, being a portion of the land this day deeded to me by Laura B. Bailey, deed not yet recorded. It is understood and agreed that all taxes for the year 1919 are to be pro-rated to date of this conveyance.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said C. H. Harris, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said C. H. Harris, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
