 NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. Mary J. Meadors of Greenville
 County in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Thirty Seven Hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. L. Henderson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. L. Henderson, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in the town of Fountain Inn, on Gulliver Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone on Gulliver Street and returning thence with Gulliver Street N. 33 E. 2.69 to an iron pin on said Gulliver Street; thence N. 13 3/4 E. 7.19 to a post; thence S. 53 1/2 W. 5.95 to a post; thence S. 36 1/4 E. 1.40 to a post; thence S. 53 1/2 W. 1.68 to a post; thence N. 11 1/2 E. 2.02 to the beginning corner, containing 1.82700 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of J. E. Jones, J. W. Richardson et al. This being the same land conveyed to me by L. B. Armstrong by deed dated 1st day of Jan'y. 1913, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Vol. # 24 of Deeds at page 79.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. L. Henderson and his heirs and assigns, forever.
