situated in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Brandon Mill, and being a part of Lot No. 7, in Block "B", of lands formerly of Melville Land Company, on plat recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", page 97 and being the same lot of land conveyed to D.C. Alberson by the Melville Land Company, by deed bearing date January 26th, 1910, and which the said D.C.
